From the President's Desk:

Dear SITians,

I wish one and all of SIT Family a Merry Christmas (belated), A Very Happy New Year and a Happy Pongal. I would like to share the progress of the construction work of our open air Auditorium. The Structure is completed in all respects and gives a majestic appearance. The flooring of the major portion of the area opposite the stage has been provided with paver blocks. The roofing over the entire area is also finished and the building presents a grand view. The photos of finished Roofing Work appear in the subsequent pages.

The civil work like providing base concrete, pedestal to receive the GIANT COLUMNS to support the Roofing system, interconnection of all columns by providing beams at plinth level, were all completed in a very short record time by our Alumnus Sri.M. Shenbagaraj of 1982 Civil batch. We owe our thanks to him.

Similarly M/s. S.R.S Colour Roofing Sheet & Fabrication Job Work of Salem who had been awarded the work of providing the ROOFING SYSTEM consisting of Fabrication and erection of columns, connecting members and finally covering the entire area of Roof with GI sheet, have done an excellent job, completing the entire work in a record time of 15 days. We owe our thanks to them also.

The estimated total cost of providing Roofing is around Rs.30 Lakhs. This is partly met with contribution from our Alumni, allocation of funds from SITAA and from the management of SIT, i.e. Seshasayee Educational Society (SES). But still there is a gap of funds spent and funds received.

The WORKS that are to be done to make the entire Auditorium fully functional include replacement of paver block flooring with proper flooring, construction of side walls, providing Doors and windows, Providing Electrical items and other finishing works. All these works may cost around Rs 40 Lakhs.

I once again appeal to our Alumni to generously contribute so that all the related works can be completed and the fully finished Auditorium can be handed over to the management of SIT.

On 28/1/2023 that is the Annual Day of our Institution, we propose to hand over the Auditorium with the recently finished Roofing System to the Management of SIT and I extend a very hearty invitation to one and all of you and request you to take part in the celebrations stated for that day.

Since the Auditorium construction is in the finishing stage, a large amount of funds is urgently required. I feel happy to note the numerous positive responses against my previous appeals, from several alumni and I wish to thank each one of our alumnus. Still I expect a good contribution from some of our Alumni along with other Alumni, whose Contact details I got only recently. The details of the events & other activities during this quarter are presented in the subsequent pages of this issue. Once again, I appeal to all our Alumni to come forward to contribute their might for the finishing of the auditorium in our SIT Campus, so that the work can be accelerated and project can be completed at the earliest. FIELD VISIT TO WATER TREATMENT PLANT IN CAUVERY RIVER BANK IN KAMBARASAMPETTAI, TRICHY

On 26-09-2022,our civil engineering department organized a field visit to the water treatment plant located on the river bank of Cauvery as a part of environmental engineering studies. All the final year and II Year Civil Engineering participated along with faculty members Sri.R.Rajasekaran, Mrs.K.M.Kanchana, Mrs.S.Revathi, Sri.R.M.Anumantha Arasan Govan, Sri.P.Srinivasan and Sri.K.Karuppanan. This water treatment plant is constructed and maintained by Trichy City Corporation.

Main Objective of the Plant:

To supply adequate potable water for drinking and other uses to the public in and around Trichy corporation limits

Profile of the Plant:

The plant was established 150 years back. Initially the water supply was made by raw water since the quality of water was good. About 50 years ago, the plant was modernized by installation of 3 infiltrations wells where the water source was obtained by gravity. The collection well was installed with a very powerful 680H.p motor with pump set. Later due to increase in demand and ground water depletion, they have erected 35 bore wells of capacity 25H.P submersible motor with pump set around the infiltration wells. Now the plant is running with the support of infiltration wells as well as bore wells. The depth of bore wells varies from 50feet-80feet using 150mm diameter G.I pipe .The capacity of the plant is 140M.L.D. The water supply is being made to 40 over head water tanks. The water supply to the city is divided into 3 major pumping units.

- 1) Main pumping station (MPS)
- 2) Turbine pumping Unit.
- 3) Collection well pumps.

In MPS, the discharge of water is supplied to 15 OHT situated in the heart of the Trichy town. The turbine pump discharges to 12 OHT at the periphery of the city. Collection well pump discharges 10 OHT to the other remaining area of the locality.

Treatment Process:

Collection: The raw water is collected from the bore well as well as infiltration wells. Two infiltration wells were constructed in the river. It has 12 radial arms which collects water from the sandy bed. The water is collected in an underground collection tank. The water sample is taken at every one hour for testing.

Disinfection: The sample is tested by orthothodiline test. The testing is conducted to determine how much chlorine (sodium hypochlorite solution) to be added to water that will be used for drinking to maintain free chlorine in the water for the average time of storage of water in the household. A free chlorine level of 0.5 mg/L of free chlorine will be enough to maintain the quality of water through the distribution network. The first option for testing uses a liquid chemical OTO (orthothodiline) that causes a color change to yellow in the presence of total chlorine. You simply fill a tube with water, add 1-5 drops of the solution, and look for the color change. This color is compared with standard chart and in turn specifies the amount of chlorination required.



Chlorination is done by means of sodium hypo chloride in liquid forms stored in large P.V.C tanks of capacity 2000litres. The dosage is measured inside the tank by measuring scale. The dosage is applied directly to the supply line by means of 1.H.P motor pump set and flexible P.V.C pipe line. Typical dosage Liquid sodium hypochlorite solution is 0.2 - 2 mg/L.

Now the plant will be further modified by constructing a large over head water tank in the plant itself and it is planned to supply water by gravity to the entire city. The D.P.R for the proposal has been submitted to the government and sanctioned for Rs.50 Crores funded under smart city scheme. The project duration is about 2 years and will be completed by December 2023.M/s Deccan Pvt.Ltd, Coimbatore was selected for above the project work.

Conclusion: This filed visit gave us knowledge about the collection and purification of water on large scale and awareness about the quality of water. The water treatment structures and machineries used for continuous supply of water gave us the knowledge in water intake structures and their design, supply and demand, forecasting future demands, etc..,
