GUEST LECTURE PROGRAMMES

Mr. K. Amudhaselvan, Loco Pilot (Mail), Southern Railway, Chennai Division and alumnus (1984–87 batch) delivered a motivational talk to the final-year Mechanical students on 15/12/2025. He inspired them by sharing his professional journey and emphasizing discipline and perseverance.
