Happenings at SIT

Guest Lecture Programme

A guest lecture was organized by the Department of Civil Engineering on 15.06.2026 to provide students with practical exposure to construction project management and execution practices. The session was delivered by Er. T. Sreevinoth, B.E., MBA, a distinguished alumnus of the 2001 Civil Engineering batch of the college and an experienced professional in the construction industry.

Er. T. Sreevinoth shared his valuable knowledge and real-world experiences regarding various stages of a construction project, beginning from the **pre-construction phase** to the **post-construction close-out stage**. He explained the importance of proper planning, coordination, quality control, and timely execution for the successful completion of projects.

During the lecture, he discussed the **Pre-Construction Stage of a Project**, which includes site due diligence, understanding client requirements, design approvals, preparation of GFC drawings, tendering processes, budget estimation, and procurement of long-lead materials.

He has created a customized daily data sheet and time schedule chart in Google data sheet. In case of any time delay in the schedule, the data sheet chart automatically rescheduled the time. He explained consequently how it affects the cost of the project due to escalation.

He further elaborated on the **Site Marking and Approval Process**, emphasizing the importance of accurate floor marking, architectural approvals, shop drawings, and material mobilization before commencing construction activities.

The speaker also explained the **Execution of Fit-Out Works**, covering aspects such as material inspection, partition works, electrical and HVAC services, false ceiling, flooring, furniture installation, testing, commissioning, and final project handover. He highlighted the importance of QA/QC procedures and proper coordination among different teams to achieve successful project delivery.

The session also covered the **Post-Construction Stage**, including project close-out reports, commercial and technical closure, handover to end users, snag list management, vendor performance

evaluation, risk assessment, and documentation of lessons learned.

Apart from the technical discussion, Er. T. Sreevinoth motivated the students by sharing the responsibilities and challenges faced by site engineers. He emphasized that a site engineer plays a crucial role in solving problems, coordinating teams, and ensuring smooth execution of construction activities.”

The lecture was highly informative and interactive. Students gained practical insights into the complete lifecycle of construction projects and understood the professional skills required in the field of civil engineering.

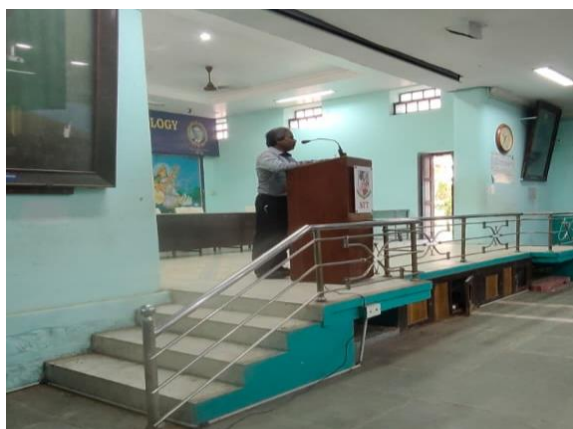
