I would like to share the progress of the construction work of our open air Auditorium. The Structure is completed in all respects and gives a majestic appearance. The flooring of the major portion of the area opposite the stage has been provided with paver blocks. The roofing over the entire area is also finished and the building presents a grand view. The photos of finished Roofing Work are published in the subsequent pages.

The WORKS that are to be done to make the entire Auditorium fully functional include replacement of paver block flooring with proper flooring, construction of side walls, providing doors, windows, providing electrical fittings and other finishing works. All these works may cost around Rs.40 Lakhs. I once again appeal to our Alumni to generously contribute so that all the related works can be completed and the fully finished Auditorium can be handed over to the management of SIT, on 14-08-2023 that is the 133rd birthday of our FOUNDER SRI.V.SESHASAYEE.



Students of Higher Secondary Vocational stream (as of March 1987) had very limited options to further pursue their academic with a professional degree. In search of a degree few opted for arts degree program. Many of such ambitious students got a golden opportunity to join ADSC Mechanical Technology a two year associate degree program, a Joint venture by SIT and Bharathidasan University Trichy. The syllabus was so designed to impart the technical knowledge, a combo of Diploma and Degree flavor with in plant training during semester holidays at industries like BHEL, TSRM, CRC, SRVS, PRC, etc. This was the dream project of our Former Principal Shri ANC. Students successfully completed the two year degree program and started their professional career. In addition to this there was as an option to join final year diploma, which many joined and completed. All these students were awarded diploma certificate in addition to ADSC Mechanical Technology certificate from the University. Though this course was existing batch between 1987-90 only these students have build their professional career well and in different capacities in India and abroad. Due to various reasons, this course has been discontinued by the University. **This batch contributed Rs.60,000 to GSANC Auditorium roofing project.**

An Example






Reunion – Golden Jubilee – 1973 SIT Alumni
