Encomium on (Late) Sri. N. Venkatramani
(15-04-1940 – 02-02-2026)

An Illustrious Alumnus of SIT, 1958 Batch Civil Engineering

Sri. N. Venkatramani was an alumnus of the then “The High School for Boys, Srirangam,” having passed SSLC in 1955. He later joined the Seshasayee Institute of Technology (SIT) during its early years at its makeshift campus within the premises of the then SMESC, Tennur. He qualified with LCE in 1958 as part of the second batch from SIT.

After obtaining his LCE, he served in the State PWD for a few years and later moved to the construction wing of the Posts and Telegraphs Department. Combined, he rendered over 23 years of service in these departments before opting for voluntary retirement (VRS). He is a Civil Pensioner.

He always had a deep affection for his alma maters—Boys High School, Srirangam, and SIT—and actively involved himself in the development of both institutions. He was also a Rotarian and served as the National Vice President of the Builders Association of India.

After taking VRS from Government service, he ventured into real estate and promoted residential flats under the name “Mangalam Flats” in Trichy, Srirangam, and surrounding areas. As an illustrious alumnus of SIT, he shared a close association with former Principals (Late) Sri. G. Sundaram (Sri GS) and (Late) Sri. Ananthanarasimhachar (Sri ANC).

His singular contributions to SIT are noteworthy. He was the driving force behind registering the SIT Alumni Association (SITAA) as a formal body in December 2013 and served as its Founder President. Today, SITAA has grown to 5,500 life members. Prior to his involvement, the association functioned informally.

In May 2014, he organized an alumni meet for his batchmates, comprising 12 septuagenarians, who gathered with their families from various places. He raised around ₹65,000 through this initiative and donated the entire amount to SIT. Even at that age, he demonstrated exceptional organizational skills and dedication.

He took the initiative to revamp the SIT canteen, which was earlier an informal shelter, by providing proper seating arrangements at his own cost. The surrounding area, which was previously swampy, was made walkable using M-sand in 2015.

He was the first alumnus to generously donate ₹1 lakh for the construction of the Alumni Building. His contributions culminated in the development of the large open-air GS-ANC Auditorium, which also houses the Alumni Office.

He also proposed the idea of establishing a scholarship fund for deserving, economically disadvantaged students of SIT. His initial contribution led to the formation of the GS-ANC Memorial Fund. With contributions from other alumni, the corpus grew to ₹20 lakhs. The interest generated from this fund supports the tuition fees of seven students every year throughout their three-year course. In special cases, it has also supported medical and hostel expenses for needy students.

In 2017, he instituted an endowment of ₹2.25 lakhs for awarding a Gold Medal to the topper of the Computer Science department at SIT. Through his enterprise, he provided on-the-job training to several SIT students in the construction field, and some of them later became entrepreneurs.

As an executive committee member of the Spastic Society of India, he played a key role in planning and constructing its building in Trichy, which received the President of India Award. He was also actively associated with organizations such as Annai Ashram, Builders Association of India, and others.

He embodied the principle of “Arjavam”—straightforwardness, where thoughts, words, and actions align perfectly. As highlighted in an article by Sri. Hasmukh Adhiya, former Finance Secretary of India, published in The Times of India on 28-01-2026, this quality defines a trustworthy and integrated personality. Sri. Venkatramani truly lived by this principle.

He spoke what he believed in and practiced what he spoke—an admirable alignment of character. He occupies a special place in the history of SIT, and his name will remain etched in golden letters on its walls.

He has left an indelible mark on every institution he was associated with. SIT has lost a valuable patron who upheld its legacy with pride, and his friends have lost a true companion.

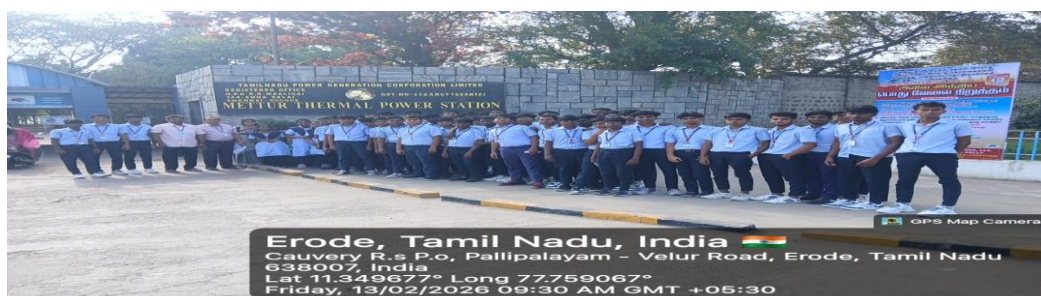
A total of 21 Civil Engineering students have joined an internship at L&T House Unit on 09th February 2026.
