Mechanical Engineering Students Association, SIT (MESA) arranged a Seminar class about MEP (Mechanical, Electrical, and Plumbing) software, conducted by A⁺

plus NDT institution for mechanical final year students (Aided & Self Finance) to learn about it, on 26^{th} & 27^{th} June, 2019

Sri.B.Lawrence from A-Plus NDT Institute introduced their institution and courses they teach. He explained the Classification of mechanical software, (Drafting, designing, analyzing) by showing flow chart and its uses.

Sri.S.Siva Chandran briefed about MEP Software and its special features, concepts of HVAC (Heating ventilation air conditioning), thermodynamics related to AC (Air Conditioners). He explained intricacies of Air conditioning system, standards used, types of AC, its applications, safety precautions, fire extinguishers and its types, working principle with video and animation.

Sri.M.Gopinath another faculty demonstrated live designing of bolt using CREO software followed by designing, assembling of engine and animation using Solid works software. He briefed the analysis of a leaf spring using ANSYS software and manufacturing of chain sprocket using master cam software.

Hand-on Training in ROBOTICS :

Department of Computer Engineering, SIT, Trichy organized a Hands-on Training in ROBOTICS held at Audio Visual Room, SIT on 10th July, 2019. All the second & third year students along with faculty have participated in this training and also all faculty members of Computer Engineering Department.

Sri. C. Manikandan, IT Support Executive, SYSTECH Academy, Trichy was the Resource Person citing the Robotics activities and encourage all the students to become an active element in the nation building processes through this robotics setup initiative and project based learning in embedded systems and robotics with Humanoid ROBOT

The event was held to make students aware about the Robotics and the benefits of carrier in it. He was informed about robotics field. These technologies are used to develop machines that can substitute for humans and replicate human actions. Robots can be used in any situation and for any purpose, but today many are used in dangerous environments (including bomb detection and de-activation), manufacturing processes, or where humans cannot survive. Information about the robotics in much greater detail was passed on to students. This helped them understand more deeply what robotics is and how they can shape their studies to form a carrier in the same.

The training also covers introduction to the Arduino board and its types with supporting devices such as sensors, motors, breadboard with connecting cables along with microcontroller and programming environment, simple motion control using I/O ports, robot velocity control using pulse width modulation, sensor

interfacing, interrupt programming, closed loop position control of robot using position encoders.

Students will gain an appreciation of the effort needed in construction and have a sense of achievement with something they have made.

Students are encouraged to do assembly and modeling of Robots.

This is a creative approach to the learning of science through real life exposure, mechanical innovation and simultaneously promotes to do hands on projects on Robots.
