Memorandum of Understanding with Tamil Nadu Newsprint Limited, Pugalur on 25-08-2023

Dr.K.Vijaykumar, Principal ic and Sri.Sinthanaiselvan, HOD ic, Paper Technology department have signed the MOU with TNPL for having Industrial tie up for our students being trained at their mills for six months during the study period.

TNPL extend their support to SIT. SIT thank TNPL for their support.

Industrial Visit – NLC India Limited (Formerly Neyveli Lignite Corporation Limited)

On 26-07-2023, 40 students final year Mechanical branch led by Dr.J.Charles Franklin and his team Dr.S.Murugan, Sri.M.Palanisamy and Sri.S.Rajamanickam.

Students were briefed about the production of 30 million tons of lignite from open cast mines and its usage for pithead thermal power stations of 3640 MW installed capacity to generate electricity. Company was started with the Russian Collaboration. Its joint venture has a 1000 MW thermal power station using lignite.

All students witnessed the coal washers. Public Relations Office (PRO), NLC allotted a guide, explained the history, evolution of mines, construction of thermal power plant having several equipment viz. lignite pulverisers, cooling towers, huge ducts, tall chimney, high pressure boilers, turbines, generators, etc. PRO explained the circuit of water, steam, superheated steam, lignite, air, flue gases, induced draft fans, forced draft fans, electrostatic precipitators, condensers, High pressure heaters etc.

Students witnessed Jawaharlal Nehru Museum where a 150-million-year-old Branch of tree is kept as sediment due to the natural decomposition and which is extracted by NLC. The whole branch of the tree has been dipped into formalin for preservation. Further they witnessed all the ancient things which were extracted by mining, including diamond and some kinds of fossil fuel of different shapes due to the natural decomposition were found below the ground this were extracted by mining and it is set to the visitor's view.

Students visited the Mine-1, where they witnessed the whole extraction process of lignite from a View Point. Keeping safety first in mind, students were allowed upto a point of transportation benches. Students witnessed the bucket machinery installed in the year 1980 at the cost Rs.150 crores. It was said that the resources getting exhausted as there were 6 machines excavating lignite since last 40 years. NLC find it difficult in extraction of lignite very difficult. Hence the first mine was abandoned now. NLC is making a new mine where they expect the pure lignite which is easy to filter and use for the further developments. New mine is under progress.

Afforestation Park Mine-1

NLC created a nice eco friendly park using the excavated sand from the mine. They grow innovative and decorative plants having beautiful flowers have excellent atmosphere. They have formed a deer park where around 160 deers are roaming happily and freely. Students had a nice experience by visiting an open mine industry, thermal power station with lignite as fuel and had the first hand industrial knowledge and how the eco environment is maintained where more than 7000 employees are working.





INDUSTRIAL VISIT -METTUR THERMAL POWER STATION

On 30-08-2023, 49 students of second year mechanical branch visited Mettur Thermal Power station. The Mettur Thermal Power Station, having coal fired high pressure boiler with accessories, High pressure steam turbines, Generators, etc. The power station located in [Thoppur-Mettur Dam-Bhavani-Erode Rd, Mettur) Salem district of Tamil Nadu. It is operated by Tamil Nadu Generation and Distribution Corporation Limited. The power station was commissioned during various periods from 1987 and this is the first inland thermal Power Station of TANGEDCO. Dr.J. Charles Franklin Lecturer, Dr.S.Murugan, Sri.S.Rajamanickam of Mechanical department coordinated the industrial visit.

Capacity of Power Generation

The first stage of this Power plant, contains the first and second units with a capacity of 210 MW worth of Rs. 348.30 Crores. Then the second stage, contains the third and fourth units with the capacity of 210MW at the cost of Rs 351.76 Crores.

Sources of Raw Materials

In this power plant, all the four units are coal dependant. This Mettur power station receives the coal stock from the states of North India. The report from the official sources says that need about 20,000 tons for each day, to operate both plants. This power plant receives the coal from the eastern coal fields limited of Orissa.

Achievements :

The MTPS- I is one of the IS/ISO 9001:2008 certified Organization. For the fly Ash Utilization, the MTPS-I had won the second prize from the Ministry of Power, Department of Science & Technology and the Ministry of Environment in 2005. Also this plant recieved a Commendation certificate, from the Ministry of Power in 2015, as an appreciation for the Energy Conservation.

For the promotion of Safety & Environment, this Plant won the Appreciation award from the National Safety Council and the Tamilnadu Government in 2014. Then, the Mettur Thermal Power station got the first position in the TANGEDCO for making the PLF achievement for the continuous four years, that is from the 2013-14 to 2016-17.

This station is the only Power plant to achieve the Annual PLF with 90% for nearly six times. In the March 2017, the new Landmark achieved in the special Oil consumption which was "Zero" for the power plant.
